

Additional capabilities to support a holistic vaccine program



PIVOT (Priority Identification Vaccine Operating Tool) to identify and inform vaccine site selection: Simulation modeling to map where target populations most vulnerable to the COVID-19 pandemic live and work to optimize vaccination clinic locations and maximize impact with scarce resources and vaccine.




VOICE (Vaccine Outreach - Implementing Community Engagement) to increase vaccine uptake and reduce vaccine hesitancy among critical populations:
